DCRIP shall not be responsible for any delay, if occurs, in delivery of BDs to the Bidder(s) by Post/Courier. Hence, Bidders are requested for sending the written request with Fee well in advance keeping in view of the bid preparation at their end and the specified delivery date and time given under paragraph 2 above.
